Networking & Outreach


APECS Sweden developed from the Swedish IPY Youth Steering Committee, which was formed in 2007 and enjoys a partnership with Vetenskapsrådet (VR), Science Council.

In the spring of 2008, APECS Sweden participated in Göteborgs Vetenskapsfestival (a science fair for primary schools) and lead discussions focused on polar science.

In the same year, we arranged an international and interdisciplinary networking workshop on Utö in the Stockholm archipelago. 25 early career polar researchers from 13 nationalities came together to discuss their career development needs, and the future of polar research in Sweden.
